



## ARRIVAL PROTOCOL

### ARRIVAL METHOD:

If arriving by bus, have the driver pull into the ranch drive just enough to get off of the road and wait at the gate for ranch interns to meet you with 4-wheelers and trailers for luggage. (We do not allow buses or RVs on the property due to busted water lines in the past.)

If you are coming in cars, have the drivers follow the signs to the parking lot. A trailer will be parked there for luggage and it will be brought to cabins to unload when everyone has arrived. (As with the bus, we don't allow cars to drive on the property except to the parking lot.)

If you have a car full of band or program "stuff," wait at the barricade and notify Stoney Creek personnel. That vehicle will be allowed to drive to the Dining Facility for unloading prior to going to the parking lot.

### **FIRST THINGS FIRST:**

- campers and leaders come immediately to the Dining Facility
- camper orientation
- proceed to cabins and make beds (It's against state policies to sleep on a bare mattresses.)
- Stoney Creek Ranch will staff officially "check-in" your group with paperwork, discuss cleaning, and give a leader orientation while kids are making beds.
- Stoney Creek Ranch staff check cabins for made beds (not army style – just sheets put on sufficiently for your group's stay)
- you are free to start your program
